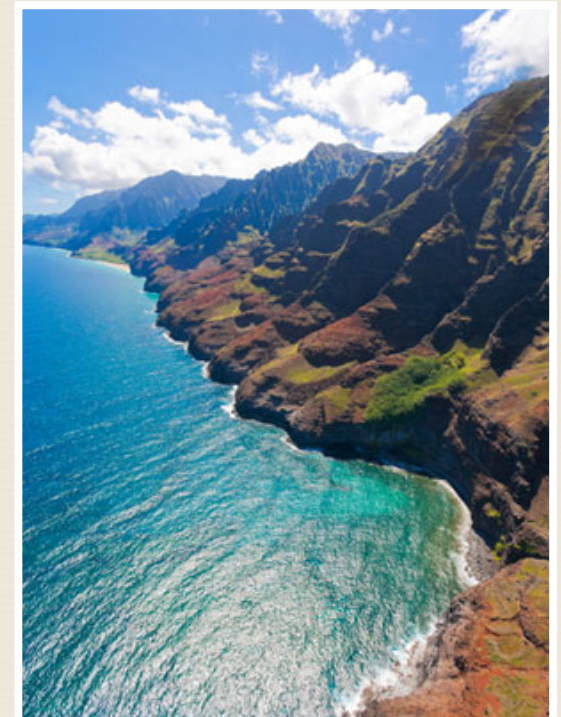

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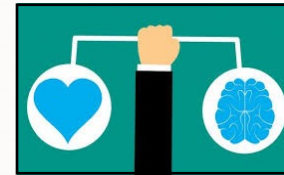

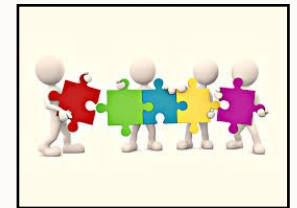
Advance Leadership oriented participants and families can work toward sponsorship to attend annual “On the Land” summer program in Western New York.

Heart-Brain Coordination

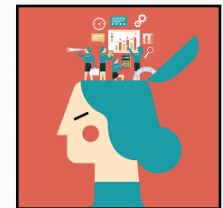


MENTORSHIP
